Mr. DREIER, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 3045) to implement the Dominican Republic-Central America-United States Free Trade Agreement.

1       *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution  
2 it shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.  
3 3045) to implement the Dominican Republic-Central  
4 America-United States Free Trade Agreement. All points  
5 of order against the bill and against its consideration are  
6 waived. The bill shall be considered as read. The bill shall  
7 be debatable for two hours equally divided and controlled

1 by the chairman and ranking minority member of the  
2 Committee on Ways and Means. Pursuant to section 151  
3 of the Trade Act of 1974, the previous question shall be  
4 considered as ordered on the bill to final passage without  
5 intervening motion.

6       SEC. 2. During consideration of H.R. 3045 pursuant  
7 to this resolution, notwithstanding the operation of the  
8 previous question, the Chair may postpone further consid-  
9 eration of the bill to a time designated by the Speaker  
10 in consonance with section 151 of the Trade Act of 1974.

11       SEC. 3. A motion to proceed to consideration of H.R.  
12 3045 pursuant to section 151 of the Trade Act of 1974  
13 shall be in order only if offered by the Majority Leader  
14 or his designee.
