resolution the House shall without intervention of any
point of order consider in the House the bill (H.R. 3764)
to establish a National Independent Inquiry Commission
on Disaster Preparedness and Response to examine and
evaluate the Federal Government's response to Hurricane

Katrina and assess its ability to respond to future large-1 2 scale disasters. The bill shall be considered as read. The 3 previous question shall be considered as ordered on the bill to final passage without intervening motion except: (1) 4 5 one hour of debate equally divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking minority member of the Committee 6 on Transportation and Infrastructure; and (2) one motion 7 to recommit. 8
