## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 3764) to establish a National Independent Inquiry Commission on Disaster Preparedness and Response to examine and evaluate the Federal Government's response to Hurricane Katrina and assess its ability to respond to future large-scale disasters.

1       *Resolved*, That immediately upon the adoption of this  
2 resolution the House shall without intervention of any  
3 point of order consider in the House the bill (H.R. 3764)  
4 to establish a National Independent Inquiry Commission  
5 on Disaster Preparedness and Response to examine and  
6 evaluate the Federal Government's response to Hurricane

1 Katrina and assess its ability to respond to future large-  
2 scale disasters. The bill shall be considered as read. The  
3 previous question shall be considered as ordered on the  
4 bill to final passage without intervening motion except: (1)  
5 one hour of debate equally divided and controlled by the  
6 chairman and ranking minority member of the Committee  
7 on Transportation and Infrastructure; and (2) one motion  
8 to recommit.
