## RESOLUTION

Expressing the sense of the House of Representatives that the United States Postal Service should issue a semipostal stamp relating to Alzheimer's disease.

- 1       *Resolved*, That it is the sense of the House of Rep-  
2       resentatives that the United States Postal Service should,  
3       under authority of section 416 of title 39, United States  
4       Code, and regulations implementing such section—  
5               (1) provide for the issuance of a semipostal  
6       stamp—  
7               (A) to promote public awareness of Alz-  
8       heimer's disease; and

1           (B) to provide a convenient way for mem-  
2           bers of the public to help fund medical research  
3           relating to Alzheimer's disease; and

4           (2) provide that the amounts becoming avail-  
5           able from the sale of such stamp be transferred to  
6           the National Institutes of Health under arrange-  
7           ments designed to carry out the purposes of this res-  
8           olution.
