**A BILL**

To reauthorize grants for the water resources research and technology institutes established under the Water Resources Research Act of 1984.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Water Resources Re-  
3 search Act Amendments of 2005”.

4 **SEC. 2. WATER RESOURCES RESEARCH.**

5 (a) **AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**—Section  
6 104(f) of the Water Resources Research Act of 1984 (42  
7 U.S.C. 10303(f)) is amended—

8 (1) in the subsection header, by striking “IN  
9 GENERAL”;

10 (2) by striking paragraph (1) and inserting the  
11 following:

12 “(1) **IN GENERAL.**—There is authorized to be  
13 appropriated to carry out this section, to remain  
14 available until expended—

15 “(A) \$12,000,000 for each of fiscal years  
16 2006 through 2008; and

17 “(B) \$13,000,000 for each of fiscal years  
18 2009 and 2010.”; and

19 (3) in paragraph (2), by striking “(2) Any” and  
20 inserting the following:

21 “(2) **FAILURE TO OBLIGATE FUNDS.**—Any”.

22 (b) **ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS WHERE RE-**  
23 **SEARCH FOCUSED ON WATER PROBLEMS OF INTERSTATE**  
24 **NATURE.**—Section 104(g) of the Water Resources Re-  
25 search Act of 1984 (42 U.S.C. 10303(g)) is amended—

1           (1) by redesignating paragraph (2) as para-  
2 graph (4); and

3           (2) in paragraph (1)—

4           (A) in the first sentence—

5           (i) by striking “(1) There” and insert-  
6 ing the following:

7           “(1) IN GENERAL.—There”; and

8           (ii) by striking “\$3,000,000 for fiscal  
9 year 2001, \$4,000,000 for *each of* fiscal  
10 years 2002 and 2003, and \$6,000,000 for  
11 *each of* fiscal years 2004 and 2005” and  
12 inserting “\$6,000,000 for each of fiscal  
13 years 2006 through 2008 and \$7,000,000  
14 for each of fiscal years 2009 and 2010”;

15           (B) in the second sentence, by striking  
16 “Such” and inserting the following:

17           “(2) NON-FEDERAL MATCHING FUNDS.—The”;

18           and

19           (C) in the third sentence, by striking  
20 “Funds” and inserting the following:

21           “(3) AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS.—Funds”.
