## A BILL

To amend title 10, United States Code, to extend child care eligibility for children of members of the Armed Forces who die in the line of duty.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF CHILD CARE ELIGIBILITY FOR**  
4 **CHILDREN OF MEMBERS OF THE ARMED**  
5 **FORCES WHO DIE IN THE LINE OF DUTY.**

6 Section 1799 of title 10, United States Code, is  
7 amended by adding at the end the following:

8 “(d) CHILDREN WHOSE MILITARY PARENT DIES IN  
9 LINE OF DUTY.—If a member of the armed forces dies  
10 on active duty, or a member of a reserve component of

1 the armed forces dies while in active service, any child of  
2 such member who is enrolled in a Federal child care pro-  
3 gram shall be eligible to continue receiving services under  
4 such program for a period of 24 months following such  
5 death.”.
