A BILL

To amend title 10, United States Code, to extend child care eligibility for children of members of the Armed Forces who die in the line of duty.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF CHILD CARE ELIGIBILITY FOR

4 CHILDREN OF MEMBERS OF THE ARMED 5 FORCES WHO DIE IN THE LINE OF DUTY.

6 Section 1799 of title 10, United States Code, is7 amended by adding at the end the following:

8 "(d) CHILDREN WHOSE MILITARY PARENT DIES IN
9 LINE OF DUTY.—If a member of the armed forces dies
10 on active duty, or a member of a reserve component of

the armed forces dies while in active service, any child of
 such member who is enrolled in a Federal child care pro gram shall be eligible to continue receiving services under
 such program for a period of 24 months following such
 death.".
