6 Delaware Canal in the State of Delaware is designated
7 as the “Senator William V. Roth, Jr. Bridge”.

9 Any reference in a law (including regulations), map,
10 document, paper, or other record of the United States to

- 1 the bridge described in section 1 shall be considered to
- 2 be a reference to the Senator William V. Roth, Jr. Bridge.
