1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF SENATOR WILLIAM V. ROTH,**  
4       **JR. BRIDGE.**

5       The State Route 1 Bridge over the Chesapeake and  
6       Delaware Canal in the State of Delaware is designated  
7       as the “Senator William V. Roth, Jr. Bridge”.

1 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

2       Any reference in a law (including regulations), map,  
3 document, paper, or other record of the United States to  
4 the bridge described in section 1 shall be considered to  
5 be a reference to the Senator William V. Roth, Jr. Bridge.
