## AN ACT

To waive the passport fees for a relative of a deceased member of the Armed Forces proceeding abroad to visit the grave of such member or to attend a funeral or memorial service for such member.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

**1 SECTION 1. PASSPORT FEES.**

2 Section 1 of the Act of June 4, 1920 (41 Stat. 750,  
3 chapter 223; 22 U.S.C. 214) is amended in the third sen-  
4 tence by striking “or from a widow, child, parent, brother,  
5 or sister of a deceased member of the Armed Forces pro-  
6 ceeding abroad to visit the grave of such member” and  
7 inserting “or from a widow, widower, child, parent, grand-  
8 parent, brother, or sister of a deceased member of the  
9 Armed Forces proceeding abroad to visit the grave of such  
10 member or to attend a funeral or memorial service for  
11 such member”.
