## A BILL

- To amend title 46, United States Code, and title II of the Social Security Act to provide benefits to certain individuals who served in the United States merchant marine (including the Army Transport Service and the Naval Transport Service) during World War II.
  - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
  - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

#### **3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the "Belated Thank You5 to the Merchant Mariners of World War II Act of 2005".

1	SEC. 2. MONTHLY BENEFIT FOR WORLD WAR II MERCHANT
2	MARINERS AND SURVIVORS UNDER TITLE 46,
3	UNITED STATES CODE.
4	(a) Monthly Benefit.—Chapter 112 of title 46,
5	United States Code, is amended—
6	(1) by inserting after the table of sections the
7	following new subchapter heading:
8	"SUBCHAPTER I—VETERANS' BURIAL AND
9	CEMETERY BENEFITS";
10	and
11	(2) by adding at the end the following new sub-
12	chapter:
13	"SUBCHAPTER II—MONTHLY BENEFIT
14	"§ 11205. Monthly benefit
15	"(a) PAYMENT.—The Secretary of Veterans Affairs
16	shall pay to each person issued a certificate of honorable
17	service pursuant to section 11207(b) of this title a month-
18	ly benefit of \$1,000.
19	"(b) SURVIVING SPOUSES.—
20	"(1) PAYMENT TO SURVIVING SPOUSES.—The
21	Secretary of Veterans Affairs shall pay to the sur-
22	viving spouse of each person issued a certificate of
23	honorable service pursuant to section $11207(b)$ of
24	this title a monthly benefit of \$1,000.
25	"(2) EXCLUSION.—No benefit shall be paid
26	under paragraph (1) to a surviving spouse of a per-

son issued a certificate of honorable service pursuant
 to section 11207(b) unless the surviving spouse was
 married to such person for no less than 1 year.

4 "(c) EXEMPTION FROM TAXATION.—Payments of
5 benefits under this section are exempt from taxation as
6 provided in section 5301(a) of title 38.

#### 7 "§ 11206. Qualified service

8 "For purposes of this subchapter, a person shall be 9 considered to have engaged in qualified service if, between 10 December 7, 1941, and December 31, 1946, the person— 11 "(1) was a member of the United States mer-12 chant marine (including the Army Transport Service 13 and the Naval Transport Service) serving as a crew-14 member of a vessel that was—

15 "(A) operated by the War Shipping Ad16 ministration or the Office of Defense Transpor17 tation (or an agent of such Administration or
18 Office);

19	"(B) operated in waters other than—
20	"(i) inland waters;
21	"(ii) the Great Lakes; and
22	"(iii) other lakes, bays, and harbors of
23	the United States;

"(C) under contract or charter to, or prop erty of, the Government of the United States;
 and

4 "(D) serving the Armed Forces; and
5 "(2) while serving as described in paragraph
6 (1), was licensed or otherwise documented for serv7 ice as a crewmember of such a vessel by an officer
8 or employee of the United States authorized to li9 cense or document the person for such service.

#### 10 "§ 11207. Documentation of qualified service

"(a) APPLICATION FOR SERVICE CERTIFICATE.—A
person seeking benefits under section 11205 of this title
shall submit an application for a service certificate to the
Secretary of Transportation, or in the case of personnel
of the Army Transport Service or the Naval Transport
Service, the Secretary of Defense.

17 "(b) ISSUANCE OF SERVICE CERTIFICATE.—The 18 Secretary who receives an application under subsection (a) 19 shall issue a certificate of honorable service to the appli-20 cant if, as determined by that Secretary, the person en-21 gaged in qualified service under section 11206 of this title 22 and meets the standards referred to in subsection (d) of 23 this section.

24 "(c) TIMING OF DOCUMENTATION.—A Secretary re-25 ceiving an application under subsection (a) shall act on

the application not later than 1 year after the date of that
 receipt.

"(d) STANDARDS RELATING TO SERVICE.—In making a determination under subsection (b), the Secretary
acting on the application shall apply the same standards
relating to the nature and duration of service that apply
to the issuance of honorable discharges under section
401(a)(1)(B) of the GI Bill Improvement Act of 1977 (38)
U.S.C. 106 note).

#### 10 **"§ 11208. Definitions**

"In this subchapter, the term 'surviving spouse' has
the meaning given such term in section 101 of title 38,
except that in applying the meaning in this subchapter,
the term 'veteran' shall include a person who performed
qualified service as specified in section 11206 of this title.

#### 16 "§11209. Authorization of appropriations

17 "There are authorized to be appropriated to the Sec-18 retary of Veterans Affairs such sums as may be necessary19 for the purpose of carrying out this subchapter.".

20 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—Subsection (c) of
21 section 11201 of title 46, United States Code, is amend22 ed—

(1) in paragraph (1), by striking "chapter" and
inserting "subchapter"; and

(2) in paragraph (2), by striking "chapter" the 1 2 second place it appears and inserting "subchapter". 3 (c) CLERICAL AMENDMENTS.—The table of sections 4 at the beginning of chapter 112 of title 46, United States 5 Code, is amended— 6 (1) by inserting at the beginning the following 7 new item: "SUBCHAPTER I-VETERANS' BURIAL AND CEMETERY BENEFITS"; 8 and 9 (2) by adding at the end the following new 10 items: "SUBCHAPTER II—MONTHLY BENEFIT

"11205. Monthly benefit.

"11206. Qualified service.

"11207. Documentation of qualified service.

"11208. Definitions.

"11209. Authorization of appropriations.".

(d) EFFECTIVE DATE.—Subchapter II of chapter
11 (d) EFFECTIVE DATE.—Subchapter II of chapter
12 112 of title 46, United States Code, as added by sub13 section (a) of this section, shall take effect with respect
14 to payments for periods beginning on or after the date
15 of the enactment of this Act, regardless of the date of ap16 plication for benefits.

# 1 SEC. 3. BENEFITS FOR WORLD WAR II MERCHANT MARI 2 NERS UNDER TITLE II OF THE SOCIAL SECU 3 RITY ACT.

4 (a) BENEFITS.—Section 217(d) of the Social Secu5 rity Act (42 U.S.C. 417(d)) is amended by adding at the
6 end the following new paragraph:

7 "(3) The term 'active military or naval service'
8 includes the service, or any period of forcible deten9 tion or internment by an enemy government or hos10 tile force as a result of action against a vessel de11 scribed in subparagraph (A), of a person who—

"(A) was a member of the United States
merchant marine (including the Army Transport Service and the Naval Transport Service)
serving as a crewmember of a vessel that was—

16 "(i) operated by the War Shipping
17 Administration or the Office of Defense
18 Transportation (or an agent of such Ad19 ministration or Office);

- 20 "(ii) operated in waters other than—
  21 "(I) inland waters;
  22 "(II) the Great Lakes; and

2	property of, the Government of the United

4	"(iv) serving the Armed Forces; and
5	"(B) while serving as described in subpara-
6	graph (A), was licensed or otherwise docu-
7	mented for service as a crewmember of such a
8	vessel by an officer or employee of the United
9	States authorized to license or document the
10	person for such service.".
11	(b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
12	subsection (a) shall apply only with respect to benefits for
13	months beginning on or after the date of the enactment

14 of this Act.
