## **AN ACT**

To amend the Communications Satellite Act of 1962 to strike the privatization criteria for INTELSAT separated entities, remove certain restrictions on separated and successor entities to INTELSAT, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

1	SECTION 1. FINANCIAL INTERESTS OF OFFICERS, MAN-
2	AGERS, OR DIRECTORS.
3	Section $621(5)(D)$ of the Communications Satellite
4	Act of 1962 (47 U.S.C. 763(5)(D)) is amended—
5	(1) by striking "(I)" in clause (ii);
6	(2) by striking "signatories, or (II)" in clause
7	(ii) and all that follows through "mechanism;" and
8	inserting "signatories; and";
9	(3) by striking "organization; and" in clause
10	(iii) and inserting "organization."; and
11	(4) by striking clause (iv).
12	SEC. 2. CRITERIA FOR INTELSAT SEPARATED ENTITIES.
13	Subtitle B of title VI of the Communications Satellite
14	Act of 1962 (47 U.S.C. 763 et seq.) is amended by strik-
15	ing section 623 (47 U.S.C. 763b).
16	SEC. 3. PRESERVATION OF SPACE SEGMENT CAPACITY OF
17	THE GMDSS.
18	Section 624 of the Communications Satellite Act of
19	1962 (47 U.S.C. 763c) is amended to read as follows:
20	"SEC. 624. SPACE SEGMENT CAPACITY OF THE GMDSS.
21	"The United States shall preserve the space segment
22	capacity of the GMDSS. This section is not intended to
23	alter the status that the GMDSS would otherwise have
24	under United States laws and regulations of the Inter-
25	national Telecommunication Union with respect to spec-
26	trum, orbital locations, or other operational parameters,

or to be a barrier to competition for the provision of
 GMDSS services.".

## **3** SEC. 4. SATELLITE SERVICE REPORT.

4 (a) ANNUAL REPORT.—The Federal Communica-5 tions Commission shall review competitive market conditions with respect to domestic and international satellite 6 7 communications services and shall include in an annual 8 report an analysis of those conditions. The Commission 9 shall transmit a copy of the report to the Senate Com-10 mittee on Commerce, Science, and Transportation and the House of Representatives Committee on Energy and Com-11 12 merce.

13 (b) CONTENT.—The Commission shall include in the14 report—

(1) an identification of the number and market
share of competitors in domestic and international
satellite markets;

(2) an analysis of whether there is effective
competition in the market for domestic and international satellite services; and

(3) a list of any foreign nations in which legal
or regulatory practices restrict access to the market
for satellite services in such nation in a manner that

- 1 undermines competition or favors a particular com-
- 2 petitor or set of competitors.
