AN ACT

To amend a provision relating to employees of the United States assigned to, or employed by, an Indian tribe, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Reducing Conflicts of
- 5 Interests in the Representation of Indian Tribes Act of
- 6 2005".

1 SEC. 2. ADDITIONAL EMPLOYMENT RIGHTS.

- 2 Section 104 of the Indian Self-Determination and
- 3 Education Assistance Act (25 U.S.C. 450i) is amended by
- 4 striking subsection (j) and inserting the following:
- 5 "(j) Additional Employment Rights.—
- 6 "(1) Definition of Tribal Employee.—In
- 7 this subsection, the term 'tribal employee', with re-
- 8 spect to an Indian tribal government, means an indi-
- 9 vidual acting under the day-to-day control or super-
- vision of the Indian tribal government, unaffected by
- the control or supervision of any independent con-
- tractor, agency or organization, or intervening sov-
- ereignty.
- 14 "(2) Rights of Certain Employees.—Not-
- withstanding sections 205 and 207 of title 18,
- 16 United States Code, an officer or employee of the
- 17 United States assigned to an Indian tribe under sec-
- tion 3372 of title 5, United States Code, or section
- 19 2072 of the Revised Statutes (25 U.S.C. 48), or an
- individual that was formerly an officer or employee
- of the United States and who is a tribal employee
- or an elected or appointed official of an Indian tribe
- carrying out an official duty of the tribal employee
- or official may communicate with and appear before
- any department, agency, court, or commission on be-
- half of the Indian tribe on any matter, including any

1	matter in which the United States is a party or has
2	a direct and substantial interest

3 "(3) Notification of involvement in pend-ING MATTER.—An officer, employee, or former offi-5 cer or employee described in paragraph (2) shall submit to the head of each appropriate department, 6 agency, court, or commission, in writing, a notifica-7 tion of any personal and substantial involvement the 8 9 officer, employee, or former officer or employee had as an officer or employee of the United States with 10 11 respect to the pending matter.".

12 SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.

- 13 The effective date of the amendment made by this
- 14 Act shall be the date that is 1 year after the date of enact-
- 15 ment of this Act.
