3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Telephone Excise Tax
- 5 Repeal Act of 2005".

1SEC. 2. REPEAL OF EXCISE TAX ON TELEPHONE AND2OTHER COMMUNICATIONS SERVICES.

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 33 of the Internal Rev4 enue Code of 1986 (relating to facilities and services) is
5 amended by striking subchapter B.

6 (b) Conforming Amendments.—

7 (1) Section 4293 of such Code is amended by
8 striking "chapter 32 (other than the taxes imposed
9 by sections 4064 and 4121) and subchapter B of
10 chapter 33," and inserting "and chapter 32 (other
11 than the taxes imposed by sections 4064 and
12 4121),".

13 (2)(A) Paragraph (1) of section 6302(e) of such
14 Code is amended by striking "section 4251 or".

(B) Paragraph (2) of section 6302(e) of such
Code is amended—

(i) by striking "imposed by—" and all that
follows through "with respect to" and inserting
"imposed by section 4261 or 4271 with respect
to", and

21 (ii) by striking "bills rendered or".
22 (C) The subsection heading for section 6302(e)
23 of such Code is amended by striking "Communica24 tions Services and".

(3) Section 6415 of such Code is amended by
 striking "4251, 4261, or 4271" each place it appears and inserting "4261 or 4271".

4 (4) Paragraph (2) of section 7871(a) of such
5 Code is amended by inserting "or" at the end of
6 subparagraph (B), by striking subparagraph (C),
7 and by redesignating subparagraph (D) as subpara8 graph (C).

9 (5) The table of subchapters for chapter 33 of
10 such Code is amended by striking the item relating
11 to subchapter B.

(c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
this section shall apply to amounts paid pursuant to bills
first rendered more than 90 days after the date of the
enactment of this Act.
