A BILL

To extend the termination date of Office of the Special Inspector General of Iraq Reconstruction and provide additional funds for the Office, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Ongoing Oversight of
5 Iraq Reconstruction Act of 2005”.

1 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENT TO TERMINATION DATE OF OFFICE OF**
2 **THE SPECIAL INSPECTOR GENERAL FOR**
3 **IRAQ RECONSTRUCTION.**

4 Subsection (o) of section 3001 of the Emergency
5 Supplemental Appropriations Act for Defense and for the
6 Reconstruction of Iraq and Afghanistan, 2004 (Public
7 Law 108–106; 117 Stat. 1234; 5 U.S.C. App. 3 section
8 8G note), as amended by section 1203(j) of the Ronald
9 W. Reagan National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal
10 Year 2005 (Public Law 108–375; 118 Stat. 2081), is
11 amended by striking “obligated” and inserting “ex-
12 pended”.

13 **SEC. 3. RECISSION OF FUNDS.**

14 Of the amount appropriated in chapter 2 of title II
15 of the Emergency Supplemental Appropriations Act for
16 Defense and for the Reconstruction of Iraq and Afghani-
17 stan, 2004 (Public Law 108–106; 117 Stat. 1224) under
18 the heading “**OTHER BILATERAL ECONOMIC ASSIST-**
19 **ANCE**” and under the subheading “**IRAQ RELIEF AND**
20 **RECONSTRUCTION FUND**”, \$50,000,000 is authorized
21 to be rescinded.

22 **SEC. 4. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

23 In addition to any other amounts authorized to be
24 appropriated for such purpose, there is authorized to be
25 appropriated \$50,000,000 for fiscal year 2006 to carry
26 out section 3001 of the Emergency Supplemental Appro-

2 Iraq and Afghanistan, 2004 (Public Law 108–106; 117
3 Stat. 1234), as amended by section 1203 of the Ronald
4 W. Reagan National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal
