- 2 **SECTION 1. WILLIAM H. EMERY POST OFFICE.**
- 3 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
- 4 Postal Service located at 520 Colorado Avenue in Arriba,

1 Colorado, shall be known and designated as the "William
2 H. Emery Post Office".

3 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
5 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
6 be deemed to be a reference to the "William H. Emery
7 Post Office".
