## A BILL

To amend the Carl D. Perkins Vocational and Technical Education Act of 1998 to modify the definition of "Indian student count".

## **3** SECTION 1. DEFINITION OF INDIAN STUDENT COUNT.

4 Section 117(h) of the Carl D. Perkins Vocational and
5 Technical Education Act of 1998 (20 U.S.C. 2327(h)) is
6 amended by striking paragraph (2) and inserting the fol7 lowing:

8 "(2) Indian student count.—

9 "(A) IN GENERAL.—The term 'Indian stu10 dent count' means a number equal to the total
