A BILL

To amend the Act of August 9, 1955, to extend the
authorization of certain leases.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION OF 99-YEAR LEASES.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subsection (a) of the first section
5 of the Act of August 9, 1955 (25 U.S.C. 415(a)), is
6 amended in the second sentence—

7 (1) by striking “Moapa Indian reservation” and
8 inserting “Moapa Indian Reservation”;

1 (2) by inserting “the reservation of the Confed-
 2 erated Tribes of the Umatilla Indian Reservation,”
 3 before “the Burns Paiute Reservation”;

4 (3) by inserting “the” before “Yavapai-Pres-
 5 cott”;

6 (4) by inserting “the Muckleshoot Indian Res-
 7 ervation and land held in trust for the Muckleshoot
 8 Indian tribe,” after “the Cabazon Indian reserva-
 9 tion,”;

10 (5) by striking “Washington,,” and inserting
 11 “Washington,”;

12 (6) by inserting “land held in trust for the
 13 Prairie Band Potawatomi Nation,” before “land held
 14 in trust for the Cherokee Nation of Oklahoma”;

15 (7) by inserting “land held in trust for the
 16 Fallon Paiute Shoshone tribes,” before “land held in
 17 trust for the Pueblo of Santa Clara”; and

18 (8) by inserting “land held in trust for the
 19 Yurok tribe, land held in trust for the Hopland
 20 Band of Pomo Indians of the Hopland Rancheria,”
 21 after “Pueblo of Santa Clara,”.

22 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
 23 subsection (a) shall apply to any lease entered into or re-
 24 newed after the date of enactment of this Act.
