## A BILL

To amend the Oregon Resource Conservation Act of 1996 to reauthorize the participation of the Bureau of Reclamation in the Deschutes River Conservancy, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Deschutes River Con-  
5       servancy Reauthorization Act of 2005”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF PARTICIPATION OF BUREAU OF**  
 2 **RECLAMATION IN DESCHUTES RIVER CON-**  
 3 **SERVANCY.**

4 Section 301 of the Oregon Resource Conservation Act  
 5 of 1996 (division B of Public Law 104–208; 110 Stat.  
 6 3009–534) is amended—

7 (1) in subsection (a)—

8 (A) in paragraph (1), by striking  
 9 “Deschutes River Basin Working Group” and  
 10 inserting “Deschutes River Conservancy Work-  
 11 ing Group”; and

12 (B) by striking paragraph (5) and insert-  
 13 ing the following:

14 “(5) QUORUM.—The term ‘quorum’ means 8 of  
 15 those qualified Working Group members appointed  
 16 and eligible to serve.”;

17 (2) in subsection (b)(3), by inserting before the  
 18 period at the end the following: “, and up to a total  
 19 amount of \$2,000,000 during each of fiscal years  
 20 2006 through 2015”; and

21 (3) in subsection (h), by inserting before the pe-  
 22 riod at the end the following: “, and \$2,000,000 for  
 23 each of fiscal years 2006 through 2015”.
