**A BILL**

To amend the Oregon Resource Conservation Act of 1996 to reauthorize the participation of the Bureau of Reclamation in the Deschutes River Conservancy, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2       This Act may be cited as the “Deschutes River Con-  
3 servancy Reauthorization Act of 2005”.

4 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF PARTICIPATION OF BUREAU OF**  
5 **RECLAMATION IN DESCHUTES RIVER CON-**  
6 **SERVANCY.**

7       Section 301 of the Oregon Resource Conservation Act  
8 of 1996 (division B of Public Law 104–208; 110 Stat.  
9 3009–534) is amended—

10           (1) in subsection (a)—

11                   (A) in paragraph (1), by striking  
12           “Deschutes River Basin Working Group” and  
13           inserting “Deschutes River Conservancy Work-  
14           ing Group”; and

15                   (B) by striking paragraph (5) and insert-  
16           ing the following:

17                   “(5) QUORUM.—The term ‘quorum’ means 8 of  
18           those qualified Working Group members appointed  
19           and eligible to serve.”;

20           (2) in subsection (b)(3), by inserting before the  
21           period at the end the following: “, and up to a total  
22           amount of \$2,000,000 during each of fiscal years  
23           2006 through 2015”; and

24           (3) in subsection (h), by inserting before the pe-  
25           riod at the end the following: “, and \$2,000,000 for  
26           each of fiscal years 2006 through 2015”.
