## A BILL

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- This Act may be cited as the "Katrina Waste, Fraud,
- 5 and Abuse Deterrence Act of 2005".
- 6 SEC. 2. ENHANCED PENALTIES.
- 7 (a) In General.—Chapter 1 of title 18, United
- 8 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-
- 9 lowing:

## 1 "§ 26. Enhanced penalties

- 2 "Whoever commits any violation of this title and such
- 3 violation involves funds appropriated for remediation of
- 4 any injury or damage caused by Hurricane Katrina shall
- 5 be fined under this title, imprisoned not less than 5 years
- 6 and not more than 20 years, or both, in addition to any
- 7 other penalty authorized.".
- 8 (b) Chapter Analysis.—The table of sections for
- 9 chapter 1 of title 18, United States Code, is amended by
- 10 adding at the end the following:

"Sec. 26. Enhanced penalties.".
