AN ACT

To extend the deadline for commencement of construction of a hydroelectric project in the State of Alaska.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF TIME FOR FEDERAL ENERGY

- 2 REGULATORY COMMISSION PROJECT.
- Notwithstanding the time period specified in section
- 4 13 of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C. 806) that would
- 5 otherwise apply to the Federal Energy Regulatory Com-
- 6 mission project numbered 11480, the Commission may, at
- 7 the request of the licensee for the project, and after rea-
- 8 sonable notice, in accordance with the good faith, due dili-
- 9 gence, and public interest requirements of that section and
- 10 the Commission's procedures under that section extend
- 11 the time period during which the licensee is required to
- 12 commence the construction of the project for 3 consecutive
- 13 2-year periods beyond the date that is 4 years after the
- 14 date of issuance of the license.
