AN ACT

To extend the deadline for commencement of construction
of a hydroelectric project in the State of Alaska.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF TIME FOR FEDERAL ENERGY**
2 **REGULATORY COMMISSION PROJECT.**

3 Notwithstanding the time period specified in section
4 13 of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C. 806) that would
5 otherwise apply to the Federal Energy Regulatory Com-
6 mission project numbered 11480, the Commission may, at
7 the request of the licensee for the project, and after rea-
8 sonable notice, in accordance with the good faith, due dili-
9 gence, and public interest requirements of that section and
10 the Commission's procedures under that section extend
11 the time period during which the licensee is required to
12 commence the construction of the project for 3 consecutive
13 2-year periods beyond the date that is 4 years after the
14 date of issuance of the license.
