A BILL

To authorize a military construction project for the construction of an advanced training skills facility at Brooke Army Medical Center, San Antonio, Texas.

3 **SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION FOR MILITARY CONSTRUC-**
4 **TION PROJECT FOR CONSTRUCTION OF**
5 **TRAINING SKILLS FACILITY.**

6 (a) MILITARY CONSTRUCTION PROJECT AUTHOR-
7 IZED.—The Secretary of Defense may carry out a military
8 construction project for the construction of an advanced
9 training skills facility at Brooke Army Medical Facility,

1 San Antonio, Texas, for the purpose of serving severely
2 injured military personnel.

3 (b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There is
4 authorized to be appropriated for fiscal year 2007 for mili-
5 tary construction of the Department of Defense
6 \$5,500,000 to defray the cost of the military construction
7 project authorized by subsection (a). Such amount is in
8 addition to any other amounts authorized to be appro-
9 priated for fiscal year 2007 for military construction of
10 the Department of Defense.
