A BILL

To extend temporarily the reduction of duty on
Thiamethoxam technical.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. THIAMETHOXAM TECHNICAL.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—

5 (1) AMENDMENT.—Heading 9902.03.11 of the
6 Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States
7 (relating to Thiamethoxam Technical) is amended by
8 striking the article description and inserting the fol-
9 lowing: “3-[(2-Chloro-5-thiazolyl)methyl]tetrahydro-
10 5-methyl-N-nitro-1,3,5-oxadiazin-4-imine)

1 (Thiamethoxam) (CAS No. 153719–23–4) (provided
2 for in subheading 2934.10.90)”.

4 (2) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made
5 by subsection (a) apply to goods entered, or with-
6 drawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
7 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this
8 Act.

9 (b) CALENDAR YEARS 2006–2008.—

10 (1) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.03.11 of the
11 Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
12 amended—

13 (A) by striking “3.2%” and inserting
14 “1.5%”; and

15 (B) by striking “12/31/2006” and insert-
16 ing “12/31/2008”.

17 (2) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made
18 by paragraph (1) shall take effect on January 1,
19 2006.

20 (c) CALENDAR YEAR 2009.—

21 (1) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.03.11, as
22 amended by this section, is further amended—

23 (A) by striking “1.5%” and inserting
24 “3.0%”; and

25 (B) by striking “12/31/2008” and insert-
ing “12/31/2009”.

1 (2) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made
2 by paragraph (1) shall take effect on January 1,
3 2009.

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
