Mr. ALLEN introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Finance

## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on electric juice extractors greater than 300 watts but less than 400 watts.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ELECTRIC JUICE EXTRACTORS GREATER THAN**

4 **300 WATTS BUT LESS THAN 400 WATTS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
6 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
7 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
8 new heading:

“	9902.85.16	Electric juice extractors greater than 300 watts but less than 400 watts (provided for in subheading 8509.40.00) .....	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2009	”.

1       (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from  
3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after  
4 the date of the enactment of this Act.
