A BILL

To redesignate the Dayton Aviation Heritage National Historical Park in the State of Ohio as the “Dayton Wright Brothers-Dunbar National Historical Park”, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Dayton Wright Broth-
5 ers-Dunbar National Historical Park Designation Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. DAYTON WRIGHT BROTHERS-DUNBAR NATIONAL**
7 **HISTORICAL PARK.**

8 (a) REDESIGNATION.—

1 (1) IN GENERAL.—Section 101(a) of the Day-
2 ton Aviation Heritage Preservation Act of 1992 (16
3 U.S.C. 410ww(a)) is amended by striking “Dayton
4 Aviation Heritage” and inserting “Dayton Wright
5 Brothers-Dunbar”.

6 (2) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—The Dayton
7 Aviation Heritage Preservation Act of 1992 is
8 amended—

9 (A) in section 1 (16 U.S.C. 410ww note;
10 Public Law 102–419), by striking “Dayton
11 Aviation Heritage” and inserting “Dayton
12 Wright Brothers-Dunbar”;

13 (B) in the heading for title I (16 U.S.C.
14 prec. 410ww), by striking “**DAYTON AVIA-**
15 **TION HERITAGE**” and inserting “**DAY-**
16 **TON WRIGHT BROTHERS-DUNBAR**”;
17 and

18 (C) in the heading for section 101 (16
19 U.S.C. 410ww), by striking “**DAYTON AVIA-**
20 **TION HERITAGE**” and inserting “**DAYTON**
21 **WRIGHT BROTHERS-DUNBAR**”.

22 (3) REFERENCES.—Any reference in any law,
23 map, regulation, document, record, or other official
24 paper of the United States to the “Dayton Aviation
25 Heritage National Historical Park” shall be consid-

1 ered to be a reference to the “Dayton Wright Brothers-Dunbar National Historical Park”.

3 (b) GRANTS.—Section 108 of the Dayton Aviation
4 Heritage Preservation Act of 1992 (16 U.S.C. 410ww-7)
5 is amended—

6 (1) by redesignating subsection (b) as sub-
7 section (c); and

8 (2) by inserting after subsection (a) the fol-
9 lowing:

10 “(b) GRANTS.—Subject to the availability of appro-
11 priations, the Secretary may provide to public and private
12 organizations grants for the preservation, development,
13 use, and interpretation of properties within the boundaries
14 of the park.”.
