AN ACT

To promote nuclear nonproliferation in North Korea.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “North Korea Non-
5 proliferation Act of 2006”.

6 **SEC. 2. STATEMENT OF POLICY.**

7 (a) In view of —

1 (1) North Korea’s manifest determination to
2 produce missiles, nuclear weapons, and other weap-
3 ons of mass destruction and to proliferate missiles,
4 in violation of international norms and expectations;
5 and

6 (2) United Nations Security Council Resolution
7 1695, adopted on July 15, 2006, which requires all
8 Member States, in accordance with their national
9 legal authorities and consistent with international
10 law, to exercise vigilance and prevent—

11 (A) missile and missile-related items, mate-
12 rials, goods, and technology from being trans-
13 ferred to North Korea’s missile or weapons of
14 mass destruction programs; and

15 (B) the procurement of missiles or missile-
16 related items, materials, goods, and technology
17 from North Korea, and the transfer of any fi-
18 nancial resources in relation to North Korea’s
19 missile or weapons of mass destruction pro-
20 grams,

21 it should be the policy of the United States to im-
22 pose sanctions on persons who transfer such weap-
23 ons, and goods and technology related to such weap-
24 ons, to and from North Korea in the same manner
25 as persons who transfer such items to and from Iran

1 and Syria currently are sanctioned under United
2 States law.

3 **SEC. 3. AMENDMENTS TO IRAN AND SYRIA NONPROLIFERA-**
4 **TION ACT.**

5 (a) **REPORTING REQUIREMENTS.**—Section 2 of the
6 Iran and Syria Nonproliferation Act (Public Law 106–
7 178; 50 U.S.C. 1701 note) is amended—

8 (1) in the heading, by inserting “, **NORTH**
9 **KOREA,**” after “**IRAN**”; and

10 (2) in subsection (a)—

11 (A) in the matter preceding paragraph

12 (1)—

13 (i) by striking “Iran, or” and insert-
14 ing “Iran,”; and

15 (ii) by inserting after “Syria” the fol-
16 lowing: “, or on or after January 1, 2006,
17 transferred to or acquired from North
18 Korea” after “Iran”; and

19 (B) in paragraph (2), by inserting “,
20 North Korea,” after “Iran”.

21 (b) **CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.**—Such Act is fur-
22 ther amended—

23 (1) in section 1, by inserting “, North Korea,”
24 after “Iran”;

1 (2) in section 5(a), by inserting “, North
2 Korea,” after “Iran” both places it appears; and

3 (3) in section 6(b)—

4 (A) in the heading, by inserting “, NORTH
5 KOREA,” after “IRAN”; and

6 (B) by inserting “, North Korea,” after
7 “Iran” each place it appears.

8 **SEC. 4. SENSE OF CONGRESS ON INTERNATIONAL CO-**
9 **OPERATION.**

10 Congress urges all governments to comply promptly
11 with United Nations Security Council Resolution 1695
12 and to impose measures on persons involved in such pro-
13 liferation that are similar to those imposed by the United
14 States Government pursuant to the Iran, North Korea,
15 and Syria Nonproliferation Act (Public Law 106–178; 50
16 U.S.C. 1701 note), as amended by this Act.
