	" 9902.90.30 Printed circuit assemblies for instruments and apparatus for measuring or checking electrical quantities, specially designed for telecommunications (provided for in subheading 9030.90.68) Free No change No change On or before 12/31/2009 ".

- 2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
- 3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after

4 the date of the enactment of this Act.
