## A BILL

To increase the number of Federal judgeships, in accordance with recommendations by the Judicial Conference, in districts that have an extraordinarily high immigration caseload.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. ADDITIONAL DISTRICT COURT JUDGESHIPS.**

4       The President shall appoint, by and with the advice  
5       and consent of the Senate, such additional district court  
6       judges as are necessary to carry out the 2005 rec-  
7       ommendations of the Judicial Conference of the United  
8       States for district courts in which the criminal immigra-

1 tion filings totaled more than 50 percent of all criminal  
2 filings for the 12-month period ending September 30,  
3 2004.
