## A BILL

To require the placement of blast-resistant cargo containers on all commercial passenger aircraft.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. BLAST-RESISTANT CONTAINERS.
- 4 (a) Requirement.—Section 41704 of title 49,
- 5 United States Code, is amended by adding at the end the
- 6 following: "Each aircraft used to provide air transpor-
- 7 tation for individuals and their baggage or other cargo
- 8 shall be equipped with not less than 1 hardened, blast-
- 9 resistant cargo container.".

- 1 (b) DISTRIBUTION TO AIR CARRIERS.—Not later
- 2 than 90 days after the completion of the Hardened Con-
- 3 tainer Pilot Program, the Secretary of Homeland Security
- 4 shall distribute sufficient blast-resistant cargo containers
- 5 to air carriers to meet the requirement under section
- 6 41704 of title 49, United States Code, as amended by sub-

7 section (a).
