3 **SECTION 1. SERGEANT FIRST CLASS ROBERT LEE “BOBBY”**

4 **HOLLAR, JR. POST OFFICE BUILDING.**

5 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
6 Postal Service located at 103 East Thompson Street in
7 Thomaston, Georgia, shall be known and designated as the

1 “Sergeant First Class Robert Lee ‘Bobby’ Hollar, Jr. Post
2 Office Building”.

3 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
5 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
6 be deemed to be a reference to the “Sergeant First Class
7 Robert Lee ‘Bobby’ Hollar, Jr. Post Office Building”.
