## A BILL

To direct the Attorney General to conduct a study on the feasibility of collecting crime data relating to the occurrence of school-related crime in elementary schools and secondary schools.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Accurate Crime Trends  
5 for Schools Act” or the “ACT for Schools Act”.

6       **SEC. 2. STUDY AND REPORT.**

7       (a) STUDY.—The Attorney General shall, after con-  
8 sultation with the Director of the Federal Bureau of In-

1 vestigation and the International Association of Chiefs of  
2 Police, conduct a study to determine the feasibility of ex-  
3 panding the National Incident-Based Reporting System to  
4 include information on the occurrence of school-related  
5 crime in elementary schools and secondary schools. Such  
6 study shall include the identification and evaluation of  
7 methods that may be used to collect and report such infor-  
8 mation.

9 (b) REPORT.—Not later than 6 months after the date  
10 of enactment of this Act, the Attorney General shall sub-  
11 mit a report containing the results of the study conducted  
12 under subsection (a) to the appropriate committees of  
13 Congress.

14 (c) DEFINITIONS.—In this section, the terms “ele-  
15 mentary school” and “secondary school” have the mean-  
16 ings given the terms in section 9101 of the Elementary  
17 and Secondary Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 7801).

18 **SEC. 3. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

19 There are authorized to be appropriated to carry out  
20 section 2, \$250,000 for fiscal year 2007.
