A BILL

To amend the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 to clarify that territories and Indian tribes are eligible to receive grants for confronting the use of methamphetamine.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. NATIVE AMERICAN PARTICIPATION IN METH-**
4 **AMPHETAMINE GRANTS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 2996(a) of the Omnibus
6 Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (42 U.S.C.
7 3797cc(a)) is amended—

1 (1) in paragraph (1)—

2 (A) in the matter preceding subparagraph
3 (A), by inserting “, territories, and Indian
4 tribes (as defined in section 2704)” after “to
5 assist States”; and

6 (B) in subparagraph (B), by striking “and
7 local” and inserting “territorial, Tribal, and
8 local”;

9 (2) in paragraph (2), by inserting “, territories,
10 and Indian tribes” after “make grants to States”;

11 (3) in paragraph (3)(C), by inserting “, Trib-
12 al,” after “support State”; and

13 (4) by adding at the end the following:

14 “(4) EFFECT OF SUBSECTION.—Nothing in this
15 subsection, or in the award or denial of any grant
16 pursuant to this subsection—

17 “(A) allows grants authorized under para-
18 graph (3)(A) to be made to, or used by, an en-
19 tity for law enforcement activities that the enti-
20 ty lacks jurisdiction to perform; or

21 “(B) has any effect other than to author-
22 ize, award, or deny a grant of funds to a State,
23 territory, or Indian tribe for the purposes de-
24 scribed in this subsection.”.

1 (b) GRANT PROGRAMS FOR DRUG ENDANGERED
 2 CHILDREN.—Section 755(a) of the USA PATRIOT Im-
 3 provement and Reauthorization Act of 2005 (Public Law
 4 109–177; 120 Stat. 192) is amended by inserting “, terri-
 5 tories, and Indian tribes (as defined in section 2704 of
 6 the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968
 7 (42 U.S.C. 3797d))” after “make grants to States”.

8 (c) GRANT PROGRAMS TO ADDRESS METHAMPHET-
 9 AMINE USE BY PREGNANT AND PARENTING WOMEN OF-
 10 FENDERS.—Section 756 of the USA PATRIOT Improve-
 11 ment and Reauthorization Act of 2005 (Public Law 109–
 12 177; 120 Stat. 192) is amended—

13 (1) in subsection (a)(2), by inserting “, terri-
 14 torial, or Tribal” after “State”;

15 (2) in subsection (b)—

16 (A) in paragraph (1)—

17 (i) by inserting “, territorial, or Trib-
 18 al” after “State”; and

19 (ii) by striking “and/or” and inserting
 20 “or”;

21 (B) in paragraph (2)—

22 (i) by inserting “, territory, or Indian
 23 tribe” after “agency of the State”; and

1 (ii) by inserting “, territory, or Indian
 2 tribe” after “criminal laws of that State”;
 3 and

4 (C) by adding at the end the following:

5 “(3) INDIAN TRIBE.—The term ‘Indian tribe’
 6 has the meaning given the term in section 2704 of
 7 the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of
 8 1968 (42 U.S.C. 3797d).”; and

9 (3) in subsection (c)—

10 (A) in paragraph (3), by striking “Indian
 11 Tribe” and inserting “Indian tribe”; and

12 (B) in paragraph (4)—

13 (i) in the matter preceding subpara-
 14 graph (A)—

15 (I) by striking “State’s services”
 16 and inserting “services of the State,
 17 territory, or Indian tribe”; and

18 (II) by striking “and/or” and in-
 19 serting “or”;

20 (ii) in subparagraph (A), by striking
 21 “State”;

22 (iii) in subparagraph (C), by inserting
 23 “, Indian tribes,” after “involved coun-
 24 ties”; and

- 1 (iv) in subparagraph (D), by inserting
- 2 “, tribal” after “Federal, State”.

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
