1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. ROCKLAND HARBOR, MAINE.

As of the date of enactment of this Act, the portion
of the project for navigation, Rockland Harbor, Maine, authorized by the Act of June 3, 1896 (29 Stat. 202, chapter
314), consisting of a 14-foot channel located in Lermond
Cove and beginning at a point with coordinates N.
999977.37, E. 340290.02, thence running easterly about
200.00 feet to a point with coordinates N. 99978.49, E.

340490.02, thence running northerly about 138.00 feet to
 a point with coordinates N. 100116.49, E. 340289.25,
 thence running westerly about 200.00 feet to a point with
 coordinates N. 100115.37, E. 340289.25, thence running
 southerly about 138.00 feet to the point of origin, is not
 authorized.
