## AN ACT

To amend the Public Health Service Act with respect to the National Foundation for the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1	SECTION 1. NATIONAL FOUNDATION FOR THE CENTERS
2	FOR DISEASE CONTROL AND PREVENTION;
3	ACCEPTANCE OF VOLUNTARY SERVICES;
4	FEDERAL FUNDING.
5	(a) Authority for Acceptance of Voluntary
6	Services; Striking Two-Year Limit Per Indi-
7	VIDUAL.—Section 399G(h)(2)(A) of the Public Health
8	Service Act (42 U.S.C. 280e–11(h)(2)(A)) is amended by
9	striking the second sentence and inserting the following:
10	"In the case of an individual, such Director may accept
11	the services provided under the preceding sentence by the
12	individual until such time as the private funding for such
13	individual ends.".
14	(b) Reports.—Section 399G(h)(7) of the Public
15	Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 280e–11(h)(7)) is amend-
16	ed—
17	(1) in subparagraph (A), by inserting ", includ-
18	ing an accounting of the use of amounts provided
19	for under subsection (i)" before the period; and
20	(2) by striking subparagraph (C) and inserting
21	the following:
22	"(C) The Foundation shall make copies of
23	each report submitted under subparagraph (A)
24	available—
25	"(i) for public inspection, and shall
26	upon request provide a copy of the report

1	to any individual for a charge not to ex-
2	ceed the cost of providing the copy; and
3	"(ii) to the appropriate committees of
4	Congress.".
5	(c) Federal Funding.—Section 399G(i) of the
6	Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 280e–11(i)) is
7	amended—
8	(1) in paragraph (2)—
9	(A) in subparagraph (A), by striking
10	"\$500,000", and inserting "\$1,250,000"; and
11	(B) in subparagraph (B), by striking "not
12	more than \$500,000" and inserting "not less
13	than \$500,000, and not more than
14	\$1,250,000''; and
15	(2) by adding at the end the following:
16	"(4) Support services.—The Director of the
17	Centers for Disease Control and Prevention may
18	provide facilities, utilities, and support services to
19	the Foundation if it is determined by the Director

- 1 to be advantageous to the programs of such Cen-
- 2 ters.".
