## RESOLUTION

To authorize representation by the Senate Legal Counsel  
in the case of Jones v. Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian  
Community, et al.

Whereas, in the case of Jones v. Salt River Pima-Maricopa  
Indian Community, et al., Civ. No. 05–1944, pending in  
the United States District Court for the District of Ari-  
zona, the plaintiff has named as defendants Senators  
John McCain and Jon Kyl; and

Whereas, pursuant to sections 703(a) and 704(a)(1) of the  
Ethics in Government Act of 1978, 2 U.S.C. §§ 288b(a)  
and 288c(a)(1), the Senate may direct its counsel to de-  
fend Members of the Senate in civil actions relating to  
their official responsibilities: Now, therefore, be it

1        *Resolved*, That the Senate Legal Counsel is author-  
2 ized to represent Senators John McCain, Jon Kyl, and  
3 other unnamed Members of the Senate in the case of  
4 Jones v. Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian Community, et
