CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for a conditional adjournment of the House of Representatives and a conditional recess or adjournment of the Senate.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That when the House adjourns on the legisla-
3 tive day of Thursday, March 29, 2007, or Friday, March
4 30, 2007, on a motion offered pursuant to this concurrent
5 resolution by its Majority Leader or his designee, it stand
6 adjourned until 2 p.m. on Monday, April 16, 2007, or
7 until the time of any reassembly pursuant to

1 section 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs
2 first; and that when the Senate recesses or adjourns on
3 Thursday, March 29, 2007, on a motion offered pursuant
4 to this concurrent resolution by its Majority Leader or his
5 designee, it stand recessed or adjourned until noon on
6 Tuesday, April 10, 2007, or such other time on that day
7 as may be specified by its Majority Leader or his designee
8 in the motion to recess or adjourn, or until the time of
9 any reassembly pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent
10 resolution, whichever occurs first.

11 SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority
12 Leader of the Senate, or their respective designees, acting
13 jointly after consultation with the Minority Leader of the
14 House and the Minority Leader of the Senate, shall notify
15 the Members of the House and the Senate, respectively,
16 to reassemble at such place and time as they may des-
17 ignate if, in their opinion, the public interest shall warrant
18 it.
