Mr. ANDREWS submitted the following concurrent resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Foreign Affairs

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Expressing the sense of Congress regarding Jordanian institutions.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring), That it is the sense of Congress that—*

3 (1) the Secretary of Education should use any
4 available resources of the Department of Education
5 and other agencies of the Executive Branch to sup-
6 port and encourage the formation of a consortia be-
7 tween one or more prominent United States institu-
8 tions of higher education and a Jordanian institu-
9 tion for the establishment of joint undergraduate
10 and graduate programs of education; and

1 (2) the Secretary of Education should assist
2 any such consortium in overcoming any legal, diplo-
3 matic, or administrative obstacles to the establish-
4 ment of such programs.
