JOINT RESOLUTION

Approving the renewal of import restrictions contained in the Burmese Freedom and Democracy Act of 2003.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. RENEWAL OF IMPORT RESTRICTIONS UNDER**
4 **THE BURMESE FREEDOM AND DEMOCRACY**
5 **ACT OF 2003.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Congress approves the renewal of
7 the import restrictions contained in section 3(a)(1) of the
8 Burmese Freedom and Democracy Act of 2003.

9 (b) RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.—This joint resolution
10 shall be deemed to be a “renewal resolution” for purposes

1 of section 9 of the Burmese Freedom and Democracy Act
2 of 2003.

3 **SEC. 2. CERTAIN COBRA FEES.**

4 Section 13031(j)(3)(B)(i) of the Consolidated Omni-
5 bus Budget Reconciliation Act of 1985 (19 U.S.C.
6 58c(j)(3)(B)(i)) is amended by striking “September 30,
7 2017” and inserting “October 7, 2017”.

8 **SEC. 3. TIME FOR PAYMENT OF CORPORATE ESTIMATED**
9 **TAXES.**

10 The percentage under subparagraph (C) of section
11 401(1) of the Tax Increase Prevention and Reconciliation
12 Act of 2005 in effect on the date of the enactment of this
13 Act is increased by 0.25 percentage points.

14 **SEC. 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

15 This joint resolution and the amendments made by
16 this joint resolution shall take effect on the date of the
17 enactment of this joint resolution or July 26, 2008, which-
18 ever occurs first.
