AN ACT

To revise the boundary of the Carl Sandburg Home National
Historic Site in the State of North Carolina, and for
other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Carl Sandburg Home
5 National Historic Site Boundary Revision Act of 2007”.

6 **SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.**

7 For the purposes of this Act:

1 (1) MAP.—The term “map” means the map en-
2 titled “Sandburg Center Alternative” numbered 445/
3 80,017 and dated April 2007.

4 (2) SECRETARY.—The term “Secretary” means
5 the Secretary of the Interior.

6 (3) HISTORIC SITE.—The term “Historic Site”
7 means Carl Sandburg Home National Historic Site.

8 **SEC. 3. CARL SANDBURG HOME NATIONAL HISTORIC SITE**
9 **BOUNDARY ADJUSTMENT.**

10 (a) ACQUISITION AUTHORITY.—The Secretary may
11 acquire from willing sellers by donation, purchase with do-
12 nated or appropriated funds, or exchange not more than
13 110 acres of land, water, or interests in land and water,
14 within the area depicted on the map, to be added to the
15 Historic Site.

16 (b) VISITOR CENTER.—To preserve the historic char-
17 acter and landscape of the site, the Secretary may also
18 acquire up to five acres for the development of a visitor
19 center and visitor parking area adjacent to or in the gen-
20 eral vicinity of the Historic Site.

21 (c) BOUNDARY REVISION.—Upon acquisition of any
22 land or interest in land under this section, the Secretary
23 shall revise the boundary of the Historic Site to reflect
24 the acquisition.

1 (d) AVAILABILITY OF MAP.—The map shall be on file
2 and available for public inspection in the appropriate of-
3 fices of the National Park Service.

4 (e) ADMINISTRATION.—Land added to the Historic
5 Site by this section shall be administered as part of the
6 Historic Site in accordance with applicable laws and regu-
7 lations.
