## AN ACT

- To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to plan, design and construct facilities to provide water for irrigation, municipal, domestic, and other uses from the Bunker Hill Groundwater Basin, Santa Ana River, California, and for other purposes.
  - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

## 1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Riverside-Corona3 Feeder Water Supply Act".

## 4 SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.

5 For the purposes of this Act, the following definitions6 apply:

7 (1) DISTRICT.—The term "District" means the
8 Western Municipal Water District, Riverside Coun9 ty, California.

10 (2) PROJECT.—The term "Project" means the
11 Riverside-Corona Feeder Project and associated fa12 cilities.

13 (3) SECRETARY.—The term "Secretary" means14 the Secretary of the Interior.

15 SEC. 3. PLANNING, DESIGN, AND CONSTRUCTION OF THE
 16 RIVERSIDE-CORONA FEEDER.

17 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary, in cooperation 18 with the Western Municipal Water District, is authorized to participate in the planning, design, and construction of 19 20 a water supply project, the Riverside-Corona Feeder, which includes 20 groundwater wells, groundwater treat-21 22 ment facilities, water storage and pumping facilities, and 23 28 miles of pipeline in San Bernardino and Riverside 24 Counties, California.

(b) AGREEMENTS AND REGULATIONS.—The Sec retary may enter into such agreements and promulgate
 such regulations as are necessary to carry out this section.
 (c) FEDERAL COST SHARE.—

5 (1) PLANNING, DESIGN, CONSTRUCTION.—The
6 Federal share of the cost to plan, design, and con7 struct the project described in subsection (a) shall be
8 not more than 25 percent of the total cost of the
9 project, not to exceed \$50,000,000.

10 (2) STUDIES.—The Federal share of the cost to 11 complete the necessary planning studies associated 12 with the project described in subsection (a) shall not 13 exceed 50 percent of the total study cost and shall 14 be included as part of the limitation on funds pro-15 vided in paragraph (1).

(d) IN-KIND SERVICES.—In-kind services performed
by the Western Municipal Water District shall be part of
the local cost share to complete the project described in
subsection (a).

(e) LIMITATION.—Funds provided by the Secretary
under this section shall not be used for operation or maintenance of the project described in subsection (a).

(f) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There isauthorized to be appropriated to the Secretary to carry

1 out this Act \$50,000,000 or 25 percent of the total cost

2 of the Project, whichever is less.
