Mr. WU (for himself, Mr. JONES of North Carolina, Mr. LARSON of Connecticut, Mr. LATOURETTE, Mr. GILCHREST, Mr. BARTLETT of Maryland, and Mr. DEFAZIO) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Armed Services, and in addition to the Committees on the Judiciary and Foreign Affairs, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned

A BILL

To preserve the right to habeas corpus.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as “The Habeas Corpus Pres-
5 ervation Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. HABEAS CORPUS.**

7 Nothing in the Military Commissions Act of 2006 or
8 any amendment made by that Act shall affect the right
9 of any resident of the United States of America to habeas

1 corpus. The preceding sentence shall be construed in ac-
2 cordance with the 5th and 14th Amendments to the Con-
3 stitution of the United States.
