- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Drug Endangered
- 5 Children Act of 2007".
- 6 SEC. 2. DRUG-ENDANGERED CHILDREN GRANT PROGRAM
- 7 EXTENDED.
- 8 Section 755(c) of the USA PATRIOT Improvement
- 9 and Reauthorization Act of 2005 (42 U.S.C. 3797cc–2(c))
