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## A BILL

To extend the grant program for drug-endangered children.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4        This Act may be cited as the “Drug Endangered  
5 Children Act of 2007”.

6 **SEC. 2. DRUG-ENDANGERED CHILDREN GRANT PROGRAM**

7                    **EXTENDED.**

8        Section 755(c) of the USA PATRIOT Improvement  
9 and Reauthorization Act of 2005 (42 U.S.C. 3797cc–2(c))  
10 is amended by striking “fiscal years 2006 and 2007” and  
11 inserting “fiscal years 2008 and 2009”.



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
