## A BILL

2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF WAIVER AUTHORITY.**

4       Section 105(b) of title IV of division B of Public Law  
5       109–148 (119 Stat. 2797) is amended by adding at the  
6       end the following new sentence: “With respect to the pro-  
7       gram authorized by section 102 of this Act, the waiver

- 1 authority in subsection (a) of this section shall be available
- 2 until the end of fiscal year 2008.”.
