AN ACT

To provide for the conveyance of a parcel of National Forest System land in Kittitas County, Washington, to facilitate the construction of a new fire and rescue station, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 2 This Act may be cited as the "Snoqualmie Pass Land
- 3 Conveyance Act".
- 4 SEC. 2. LAND CONVEYANCE, NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM
- 5 LAND, KITTITAS COUNTY, WASHINGTON.
- 6 (a) Conveyance Required.—The Secretary of Ag-
- 7 riculture shall convey, without consideration, to the King
- 8 and Kittitas Counties Fire District #51 of King and
- 9 Kittitas Counties, Washington (in this section referred to
- 10 as the "District"), all right, title, and interest of the
- 11 United States in and to a parcel of National Forest Sys-
- 12 tem land in Kittitas County, Washington, consisting of ap-
- 13 proximately 1.5 acres within the SW¹/₄ of the SE¹/₄ of
- 14 section 4, township 22 north, range 11 east, Willamette
- 15 meridian, for the purpose of permitting the District to use
- 16 the parcel as a site for a new Snoqualmie Pass fire and
- 17 rescue station.
- 18 (b) Reversionary Interest.—If the Secretary de-
- 19 termines at any time that the real property conveyed
- 20 under subsection (a) is not being used in accordance with
- 21 the purpose of the conveyance specified in such subsection,
- 22 all right, title, and interest in and to the property shall
- 23 revert, at the option of the Secretary, to the United States,
- 24 and the United States shall have the right of immediate
- 25 entry onto the property. Any determination of the Sec-

- 1 retary under this subsection shall be made on the record
- 2 after an opportunity for a hearing.
- 3 (c) Survey.—If necessary, the exact acreage and
- 4 legal description of the lands to be conveyed under sub-
- 5 section (a) shall be determined by a survey satisfactory
- 6 to the Secretary. The cost of a survey shall be borne by
- 7 the District.
- 8 (d) Additional Terms and Conditions.—The
- 9 Secretary may require such additional terms and condi-
- 10 tions in connection with the conveyance under subsection
- 11 (a) as the Secretary considers appropriate to protect the
- 12 interests of the United States.
