3 SECTION 1. PROVISION OF SPECIALLY ADAPTIVE HOUSING
4 ASSISTANCE TO DISABLED MEMBERS OF THE
5 ARMED FORCES RESIDING TEMPORARILY IN
6 HOUSING OWNED BY A FAMILY MEMBER.
7 Section 2102A of title 38, United States Code, is

1	(1) by redesignating subsections (d) and (e) as
2	subsections (e) and (f), respectively; and
3	(2) by inserting after subsection (c) the fol-
4	lowing new subsection (d):
5	"(c) Assistance for Members of the Armed
6	FORCES.—The Secretary may provide assistance under
7	subsection (a) to a member of the Armed Forces serving
8	on active duty who is suffering from a disability described
9	in subsection $(a)(2)$ or $(b)(2)$ of section 2101 of this title
10	if such disability is the result of an injury incurred or dis-
11	ease contracted in or aggravated in the line of duty in
12	the active military, naval, or air service. Such assistance
13	shall be provided to the same extent as assistance is pro-
14	vided under subsection (a) to veterans eligible for assist-
15	ance under that subsection and subject to the limitation
16	under subsection (c).".
