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## A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to provide specially adaptive housing assistance to certain disabled members of the Armed Forces residing temporarily in housing owned by a family member.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. PROVISION OF SPECIALLY ADAPTIVE HOUSING**  
2 **ASSISTANCE TO DISABLED MEMBERS OF THE**  
3 **ARMED FORCES RESIDING TEMPORARILY IN**  
4 **HOUSING OWNED BY A FAMILY MEMBER.**

5 Section 2102A of title 38, United States Code, is  
6 amended—

7 (1) by redesignating subsections (d) and (e) as  
8 subsections (e) and (f), respectively; and

9 (2) by inserting after subsection (e) the fol-  
10 lowing new subsection (d):

11 “(e) **ASSISTANCE FOR MEMBERS OF THE ARMED**  
12 **FORCES.**—The Secretary may provide assistance under  
13 subsection (a) to a member of the Armed Forces serving  
14 on active duty who is suffering from a disability described  
15 in subsection (a)(2) or (b)(2) of section 2101 of this title  
16 if such disability is the result of an injury incurred or dis-  
17 ease contracted in or aggravated in the line of duty in  
18 the active military, naval, or air service. Such assistance  
19 shall be provided to the same extent as assistance is pro-  
20 vided under subsection (a) to veterans eligible for assist-  
21 ance under that subsection and subject to the limitation  
22 under subsection (e).”.

23 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

24 *This Act may be cited as the “Veterans’ Benefits Im-*  
25 *provement Act of 2007”.*

1 **SEC. 2. PROVISION OF SPECIALLY ADAPTIVE HOUSING AS-**  
2 **SISTANCE TO DISABLED MEMBERS OF THE**  
3 **ARMED FORCES RESIDING TEMPORARILY IN**  
4 **HOUSING OWNED BY A FAMILY MEMBER.**

5 *Section 2102A of title 38, United States Code, is*  
6 *amended—*

7 *(1) by redesignating subsections (d) and (e) as*  
8 *subsections (e) and (f), respectively; and*

9 *(2) by inserting after subsection (c) the following*  
10 *new subsection (d):*

11 *“(d) ASSISTANCE FOR MEMBERS OF THE ARMED*  
12 *FORCES.—The Secretary may provide assistance under*  
13 *subsection (a) to a member of the Armed Forces serving on*  
14 *active duty who is suffering from a disability described in*  
15 *subsection (a)(2) or (b)(2) of section 2101 of this title if*  
16 *such disability is the result of an injury incurred or disease*  
17 *contracted in or aggravated in line of duty in the active*  
18 *military, naval, or air service. Such assistance shall be pro-*  
19 *vided to the same extent as assistance is provided under*  
20 *subsection (a) to veterans eligible for assistance under that*  
21 *subsection and subject to the limitation under subsection*  
22 *(c).”.*

1 **SEC. 3. EXTENSION OF PERIOD OF MORTGAGE FORE-**  
2 **CLOSURE PROTECTION UNDER**  
3 **SERVICEMEMBERS CIVIL RELIEF ACT.**

4 (a) *EXTENSION TO 6 MONTHS.*—Subsection (c) of sec-  
5 tion 303 of the Servicemembers Civil Relief Act (50 U.S.C.  
6 App. 533(c)) is amended by striking “90 days” and insert-  
7 ing “180 days”.

8 (b) *EXTENSION OF PERIOD OF INTEREST RATE LIM-*  
9 *TATION.*—Such section is further amended by adding at the  
10 end the following new subsection:

11 “(e) *APPLICABILITY OF INTEREST RATE LIMITA-*  
12 *TION.*—Section 207 shall apply with respect to an obliga-  
13 tion described in subsection (a) during the 180-day period  
14 beginning on the last day of the period of the  
15 servicemember’s military service in the same manner that  
16 section applies with respect to such an obligation during  
17 the period of the servicemember’s military service.”.

18 (c) *EFFECTIVE DATE.*—The amendments made by sub-  
19 sections (a) and (b) shall apply with respect to any person  
20 performing a period of military service (as such term is  
21 defined in section 101(2) of such Act (50 U.S.C. App.  
22 511(2))) that begins on or after the date that is 90 days  
23 after the date of the enactment of this Act.

1 **SEC. 4. VISUAL IMPAIRMENT AND ORIENTATION AND MO-**  
2 **BILITY PROFESSIONALS EDUCATION ASSIST-**  
3 **ANCE PROGRAM.**

4 (a) *ESTABLISHMENT OF PROGRAM.*—Chapter 76 of  
5 title 38, United States Code, is amended by adding at the  
6 end the following new subchapter:

7 “SUBCHAPTER VIII—VISUAL IMPAIRMENT AND  
8 ORIENTATION AND MOBILITY PROFES-  
9 SIONALS SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

10 “§ 7691. **Authority for program**

11 “As part of the Educational Assistance Program and  
12 subject to the availability of appropriations for such pur-  
13 pose, the Secretary shall carry out a scholarship program  
14 under this subchapter. The program shall be known as the  
15 Department of Veterans Affairs Visual Impairment and  
16 Orientation and Mobility Professionals Scholarship Pro-  
17 gram (hereinafter in this subchapter referred to as the ‘Pro-  
18 gram’). The purpose of the Program is to increase the sup-  
19 ply of qualified blind rehabilitation specialists for the De-  
20 partment and the Nation.

21 “§ 7692. **Eligibility; agreement**

22 “(a) *ELIGIBILITY.*—To be eligible to participate in the  
23 Program, an individual must be accepted for enrollment or  
24 enrolled (as described in section 7602 of this title) as a full-  
25 time or part-time student in a field of education or training  
26 described in subsection (b).

1       “(b) *QUALIFYING FIELDS OF EDUCATION OR TRAIN-*  
2 *ING.*—*A field of education or training described in this sub-*  
3 *section is education or training leading to—*

4               “(1) *a degree or certificate in visual impairment*  
5 *or orientation and mobility, or a dual degree or cer-*  
6 *tification in both such areas; and*

7               “(2) *appointment or retention in a position*  
8 *under section 7401 of this title.*

9       “(c) *AGREEMENT.*—(1) *An agreement between the Sec-*  
10 *retary and a participant in the Program shall (in addition*  
11 *to the requirements set forth in section 7604 of this title)*  
12 *include the following:*

13               “(A) *The Secretary’s agreement to provide the*  
14 *participant with a scholarship under the Program for*  
15 *a specified number (from one to three) of school years*  
16 *during which the participant pursues a course of edu-*  
17 *cation or training described in subsection (b) that*  
18 *meets the requirements set forth in section 7602(a) of*  
19 *this title.*

20               “(B) *The participant’s agreement to serve as a*  
21 *full-time employee in the Veterans Health Adminis-*  
22 *tration for a period of three years (hereinafter in this*  
23 *subchapter referred to as the ‘period of obligated serv-*  
24 *ice’) during the six-year period beginning on the date*  
25 *the participant completes the education or training*

1       and receives a degree or certificate described in sub-  
2       section (b)(1).

3               “(C) The participant’s agreement to serve under  
4       subparagraph (B) in a Department facility selected  
5       by the Secretary.

6       “(2) In a case in which an extension is granted under  
7       section 7673(c)(2) of this title, the number of years for  
8       which a scholarship may be provided under the Program  
9       shall be the number of school years provided for as a result  
10      of the extension.

11       “(3) In the case of a participant who is a part-time  
12      student, the period of obligated service shall be reduced in  
13      accordance with the proportion that the number of credit  
14      hours carried by such participant in any such school year  
15      bears to the number of credit hours required to be carried  
16      by a full-time student in the course of training being pur-  
17      sued by the participant, but in no event to less than one  
18      year.

19      **“§ 7693. Scholarship**

20       “(a) SCHOLARSHIP.—A scholarship provided to a par-  
21      ticipant in the Program for a school year shall consist of  
22      payment of the tuition (or such portion of the tuition as  
23      may be provided under subsection (b)) of the participant  
24      for that school year and payment of other reasonable edu-

1 *cational expenses (including fees, books, and laboratory ex-*  
2 *penses) for that school year.*

3 “(b) *AMOUNTS.—The total amount of the scholarship*  
4 *payable under subsection (a)—*

5 “(1) *in the case of a participant in the Program*  
6 *who is a full-time student, may not exceed \$15,000 for*  
7 *the equivalent of one year of full-time coursework; and*

8 “(2) *in the case of a participant in the Program*  
9 *who is a part-time student, shall bear the same ratio*  
10 *to the amount that would be paid under paragraph*  
11 *(1) if the participant were a full-time student in the*  
12 *course of education or training being pursued by the*  
13 *participant as the coursework carried by the partici-*  
14 *part to full-time coursework in that course of edu-*  
15 *cation or training.*

16 “(c) *LIMITATIONS ON PERIOD OF PAYMENT.—(1) The*  
17 *maximum number of school years for which a scholarship*  
18 *may be paid under subsection (a) to a participant in the*  
19 *Program shall be six school years.*

20 “(2) *A participant in the Program may not receive*  
21 *a scholarship under subsection (a) for more than the equiva-*  
22 *lent of three years of full-time coursework.*

23 “(d) *PAYMENT OF EDUCATIONAL EXPENSES BY EDU-*  
24 *CATIONAL INSTITUTIONS.—The Secretary may arrange*  
25 *with an educational institution in which a participant in*



1 *the Program is enrolled for the payment of the educational*  
2 *expenses described in subsection (a). Such payments may*  
3 *be made without regard to subsections (a) and (b) of section*  
4 *3324 of title 31.*

5       “(e) *FULL-TIME COURSEWORK.*—*For purposes of this*  
6 *section, full-time coursework shall consist of the following:*

7               “(1) *In the case of undergraduate coursework, 30*  
8 *semester hours per undergraduate school year.*

9               “(2) *In the case of graduate coursework, 18 se-*  
10 *mester hours per graduate school year.*

11 **“§ 7694. *Obligated service***

12       “(a) *IN GENERAL.*—*Each participant in the Program*  
13 *shall provide service as a full-time employee of the Depart-*  
14 *ment for the period of obligated service provided in the*  
15 *agreement of the participant entered into under section*  
16 *7604 of this title. Such service shall be provided in the full-*  
17 *time clinical practice of such participant’s profession or in*  
18 *another health-care position in an assignment or location*  
19 *determined by the Secretary.*

20       “(b) *DETERMINATION OF SERVICE COMMENCEMENT*  
21 *DATE.*—(1) *Not later than 60 days before a participant’s*  
22 *service commencement date, the Secretary shall notify the*  
23 *participant of that service commencement date. That date*  
24 *is the date for the beginning of the participant’s period of*  
25 *obligated service.*

1       “(2) *As soon as possible after a participant’s service*  
2 *commencement date, the Secretary shall—*

3               “(A) *in the case of a participant who is not a*  
4 *full-time employee in the Veterans Health Adminis-*  
5 *tration, appoint the participant as such an employee;*  
6 *and*

7               “(B) *in the case of a participant who is an em-*  
8 *ployee in the Veterans Health Administration but is*  
9 *not serving in a position for which the participant’s*  
10 *course of education or training prepared the partici-*  
11 *phant, assign the participant to such a position.*

12       “(3)(A) *In the case of a participant receiving a degree*  
13 *from a school of medicine, osteopathy, dentistry, optometry,*  
14 *or podiatry, the participant’s service commencement date*  
15 *is the date upon which the participant becomes licensed to*  
16 *practice medicine, osteopathy, dentistry, optometry, or po-*  
17 *diatry, as the case may be, in a State.*

18       “(B) *In the case of a participant receiving a degree*  
19 *from a school of nursing, the participant’s service com-*  
20 *mencement date is the later of—*

21               “(i) *the participant’s course completion date; or*

22               “(ii) *the date upon which the participant be-*  
23 *comes licensed as a registered nurse in a State.*

1       “(C) *In the case of a participant not covered by sub-*  
2 *paragraph (A) or (B), the participant’s service commence-*  
3 *ment date is the later of—*

4               “(i) *the participant’s course completion date; or*  
5               “(ii) *the date the participant meets any applica-*  
6 *ble licensure or certification requirements.*

7       “(4) *The Secretary shall by regulation prescribe the*  
8 *service commencement date for participants who were part-*  
9 *time students. Such regulations shall prescribe terms as*  
10 *similar as practicable to the terms set forth in paragraph*  
11 *(3).*

12       “(c) *COMMENCEMENT OF OBLIGATED SERVICE.—(1)*  
13 *Except as provided in paragraph (2), a participant in the*  
14 *Program shall be considered to have begun serving the par-*  
15 *ticipant’s period of obligated service—*

16               “(A) *on the date, after the participant’s course*  
17 *completion date, on which the participant (in accord-*  
18 *ance with subsection (b)) is appointed as a full-time*  
19 *employee in the Veterans Health Administration; or*

20               “(B) *if the participant is a full-time employee in*  
21 *the Veterans Health Administration on such course*  
22 *completion date, on the date thereafter on which the*  
23 *participant is assigned to a position for which the*  
24 *participant’s course of training prepared the partici-*  
25 *pant.*



1           “(c) *WAIVER OR SUSPENSION OF COMPLIANCE.*—The  
 2 *Secretary shall prescribe regulations providing for the*  
 3 *waiver or suspension of any obligation of an individual for*  
 4 *service or payment under this subchapter (or an agreement*  
 5 *under this subchapter) whenever noncompliance by the in-*  
 6 *dividual is due to circumstances beyond the control of the*  
 7 *individual or whenever the Secretary determines that the*  
 8 *waiver or suspension of compliance is in the best interest*  
 9 *of the United States.*

10           “(d) *OBLIGATION AS DEBT TO UNITED STATES.*—An  
 11 *obligation to repay the Secretary under this section is, for*  
 12 *all purposes, a debt owed the United States. A discharge*  
 13 *in bankruptcy under title 11 does not discharge a person*  
 14 *from such debt if the discharge order is entered less than*  
 15 *five years after the date of the termination of the agreement*  
 16 *or contract on which the debt is based.”.*

17           “(b) *CLERICAL AMENDMENT.*—The tables of sections at  
 18 *the beginning of such chapter is amended by inserting after*  
 19 *the items relating to subchapter VII the following new*  
 20 *items:*

“SUBCHAPTER VIII—VISUAL IMPAIRMENT AND ORIENTATION AND MOBILITY  
 PROFESSIONALS SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

“7691. *Authority for program.*

“7692. *Eligibility; agreement.*

“7693. *Scholarship.*

“7694. *Obligated service.*

“7695. *Repayment for failure to satisfy requirements of agreement.”.*

21           “(c) *CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.*—Such chapter is fur-  
 22 *ther amended—*

1           (1) *in section 7601(a)—*

2                   (A) *in paragraph (4), by striking “and” at*  
3           *the end;*

4                   (B) *in paragraph (5), by striking the period*  
5           *and inserting “; and”; and*

6                   (C) *by adding at the end the following new*  
7           *paragraph:*

8                   “*(6) the Visual Impairment and Orientation*  
9           *and Mobility Professionals Scholarship Program pro-*  
10           *vided for in subchapter VIII of this chapter.”;*

11           (2) *in section 7602—*

12                   (A) *in subsection (a)(1)—*

13                           (i) *by striking “or VI” and inserting*  
14                   “*VI, or VIII*”; *and*

15                           (ii) *by striking “or for which a schol-*  
16                   *arship may be awarded under subchapter*  
17                   *VI of this chapter” and inserting “for which*  
18                   *a scholarship may be awarded under sub-*  
19                   *chapter VI of this chapter, or for which a*  
20                   *scholarship may be awarded under sub-*  
21                   *chapter VIII of this chapter”;* *and*

22                   (B) *in subsection (b), by striking “or VI”*  
23           *and inserting “VI, or VIII”;*

24           (3) *in section 7603(a)(1), by striking “or VI”*  
25           *and inserting “VI, or VIII”;* *and*

1           (4) in section 7604, by striking “or VI” each  
2           place it appears and inserting “VI, or VIII”.

3           (d) *EFFECTIVE DATE.*—The Secretary of Veterans Af-  
4           airs shall implement subchapter VIII of chapter 76 of title  
5           38, United States Code, as added by section 1, not later  
6           than six months after the date of the enactment of this Act.

7           **SEC. 5. VETERANS’ REEMPLOYMENT RIGHTS REPORT IM-**  
8           **PROVEMENT.**

9           (a) *ADDITIONAL REPORT REQUIREMENTS.*—Section  
10          4332 of title 38, United States Code, is amended—

11           (1) by striking “The Secretary shall” and insert-  
12          ing “(a) *REPORT REQUIRED.*—The Secretary shall”;

13           (2) by redesignating paragraphs (4) through (6)  
14          as paragraphs (5) through (7), respectively, and in-  
15          serting after paragraph (3) the following new para-  
16          graph (4):

17           “(4) The number of cases reviewed by the Sec-  
18          retary of Defense under the National Committee for  
19          Employer Support of the Guard and Reserve of the  
20          Department of Defense during the fiscal year for  
21          which the report is made.”;

22           (3) in paragraph (5), as so redesignated, by  
23          striking “or (3)” and inserting “(3), or (4)”;

1           (4) by redesignating paragraph (7), as so rededesignated, as paragraph (8), and inserting after paragraph (6) the following new paragraph (7):

2           “(7) An indication of which of the cases reported on pursuant to paragraphs (1), (2), (3), and (4) are disability-related.”; and

3           (5) by adding at the end the following new subsections:

4           “(b) *UNIFORM CATEGORIZATION OF DATA.*—The Secretary shall coordinate with the Secretary of Defense, the Secretary of Veterans Affairs, the Attorney General, and the Special Counsel to ensure that the information required to be submitted as part of the report under subsection (a) is categorized in a uniform way.

5           “(c) *PROVISION OF INFORMATION.*—The Secretary shall provide the information contained in the report required under subsection (a) to the Secretary of Defense, the Secretary of Veterans Affairs, the Attorney General, and the Special Counsel.”.

6           “(b) *EFFECTIVE DATE.*—The amendments made by this section shall apply with respect to a report submitted after the date of the enactment of this Act.



1 **SEC. 6. INCREASE IN NUMBER OF MEMBERS OF ADVISORY**  
2 **COMMITTEE ON VETERANS EMPLOYMENT,**  
3 **TRAINING, AND EMPLOYER OUTREACH.**

4 *Section 4110(c)(1) of title 38, United States Code, is*  
5 *amended by striking “15” and inserting “16”.*

Amend the title so as to read: “A bill to amend title 38, United States Code, to make certain improvements in the benefits provided to veterans under laws administered by the Secretary of Veterans Affairs, and for other purposes.”.
