A BILL

 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as "Logan's Law".

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CLOSED FLOOD OR DRAINAGE SYSTEMS.

3 (a) SAFETY REQUIREMENTS.—The head of a Federal
4 department or agency that is carrying out a project involv5 ing the construction or modification of a culvert or other
6 enclosed flood or drainage system shall ensure that—

7 (1) the intake to the culvert or other enclosed 8 flood or drainage system is protected by a bar, 9 grate, or other appropriate covering sufficient to en-10 sure that a child may not be swept into the system; 11 (2) a sign warning of the hazard for a child, in-12 cluding the danger for injury or drowning, is clearly 13 posted at the intake to the culvert or other enclosed 14 flood or drainage system; and

(3) the culvert or other enclosed flood or drainage system has a hinged opening or other type of
opening and closing mechanism to permit emergency
services personnel to access the system.

(b) APPLICABILITY.—Subsection (a) shall apply to—
(1) a project carried out after the effective date
of this Act directly by the head of a Federal department or agency; and

(2) a project carried out in whole or in part
with Federal funds made available by the head of a
Federal department or agency after the effective
date of this Act.

1 (c) CONDITIONS ON FEDERAL FINANCIAL ASSIST-2 ANCE.—In the case of a project described in subsection 3 (b)(2), the head of the Federal department or agency pro-4 viding Federal financial assistance to a State or local gov-5 ernment or other entity shall require compliance with sub-6 section (a) as a condition for the award of the financial 7 assistance or any letter of intent.

8 (d) EFFECTIVE DATE.—This Act shall take effect be-9 ginning 180 days after the date of enactment of this Act.

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
